Dear parishioners,

As we approach the great feast of Pascha, we are faced with many questions due to the restrictions associated with the Corona virus. We are not able to do things "as usual". One such problem is the sale of kulichi and cheese paschas. In the past we sold them at the cathedral after services or during lunches. We are in lockdown mode and we have been instructed to close our doors to the public. We are still able to order kulichi and our sisters have prepared the cheese paschas but in order to get them to our parishioners, we must sell the items as "take out". Father Serge will bless the kulichi before you receive them since gatherings are not permitted and we will not be blessing baskets in the hall this year.

We are asking you to let us know by 5pm this Friday, April 3 if you would like to order kulichi, what size and how many. The prices are the same as last year: KULICHI 1 lb. - \$10, 2 lbs. - \$20, 3 lbs. - \$30

A limited number of cheese paschas are available. They are sold by weight. Most run between \$19 and \$23. We do have a few smaller ones and a few larger ones.

When we receive the kulichi, we will package them and they will be available for pick up at the parish hall. We will work out the final details once we know how many have been ordered.

It is imperative that you place your order on time, otherwise we cannot guarantee that we will have kulichi available for you.
